The Minister of Health;

Pursuant to the Constitution of the Republic of Rwanda of 2003 revised in 2015, especially in Articles 121, 122 and 176;

Pursuant to Law n° 46/2012 of 14/01/2013 establishing the Rwanda Allied Health Professions Council and determining its organisation, functioning and competence, especially in Article 3;

After consideration and approval by the Cabinet, in its session of 09/12/2016;

HEREBY ORDERS:

Article One - Purpose of this Order

This Order determines additional allied health professions.

Article 2 – Other allied health professions

Allied health professions include additional professions as follows:

- 1° clinical Perfusionists;
- 2° hearing Instrument Dispensers;
- 3° clinical Officers/Medical Assistants;
- 4° social Workers;
- 5° speech & Language Therapists;
- 6° chiropractors.

Article 3 - Repealing provision

All prior provisions contrary to this Order are repealed.

Article 4 - Commencement

This Order comes into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Rwanda.
